We are currently looking to hire a full time Children's Ministry Pastor who reports directly to the Family Life Pastor.

Job Description

The Children's Ministry Pastor will work closely with the Family Life Pastor in strategically implementing the vision of the Children's Ministry to bless, equip and encourage children in their faith. They will be responsible for implementing the smooth running of Kidz 4 Christ (K4C) every Sunday, as well as supporting and supervising mid-week activities which include Mainly Music, Mother and Toddler group and Refugee and Asylum Seekers Ministry (RAS).

Job Responsibilities

- Work alongside the Family Life Pastor to pray, dream and cast vision for Children's Ministry.
- Partner with the Family Life Pastor to strategise and implement vision.
- Coordinate Sunday K4C services.
- Teach various K4C classes as needed.
- Procure materials and supplies.
- Recruit and help manage Children's Ministry volunteer team.
- Be committed to building a volunteer community within the Children's Ministry.
- Manage Planning Center Online for monthly rostering and uploading of Curriculums.
- Research and source relevant Children's Ministry Curriculums.
- Coordinate and support Mainly Music and the volunteer team.
- Provide RAS support for Children's Church midweek.
- Attend and participate in weekly staff devotions and pastoral team meetings/trainings.
- Flexibility to represent Children's Ministry at church wide events / meetings when needed
- Partner with Family Life for special events and support church wide ministries/events.

Job Requirement

- Theology trained, and degree level or equivalent.
- Minimum 3 years' experience working with a sizeable group of children.
