



Children's Ministry Pastor

The Vine is a multi-cultural, inter-denominational, vibrant church community based in the Wan Chai district of Hong Kong. We are both a local and an international family, made up of people born and raised in Hong Kong, as well as those who have moved here from other countries. We are currently looking to hire a full time Children's Ministry Pastor who reports directly to Young Adult Pastor.

The Children's Ministry Pastor is a member of the Vine pastoral team with a dedicated focus on the spiritual formation of our children as well as equipping Vine families as they grow in their faith. The Children's Pastor is an integral member of the Generation Team comprising of Children, Youth and Young Adults. The role and responsibilities are as follows:

1. Children's Ministry

- Strategise and implement vision.
- Coordinate Sunday K4C services.
- Provide pastoral care for families.
- Teach various K4C classes as needed.
- Procure materials and supplies.
- Recruit and help manage Children's Ministry volunteer team.
- Be committed to building a volunteer community within the Children's Ministry.
- Manage Planning Center Online for monthly rostering and uploading of Curriculums.
- Research and source relevant Children's Ministry Curriculums.
- Coordinate and support mainly music and the volunteer team.
- Collaborate with ROAD Ministry to support them in spiritually leading the refugee and asylum seekers families
- Flexibility to represent Children's Ministry at church wide events / meetings when needed

2. Pastoral Team

- Participate fully in Pastoral Team meetings and Generation Team meetings
- Participate in pastor training and staff devotions
- Collaborate with the Pastoral Team around wider Vine ministry

Job Requirement

- Fluent in written and spoken English and Cantonese.
- Theology trained, and degree level or equivalent.
- Minimum 3 years' experience working with a sizeable group of children.
- Attentive, caring and a pastoral heart for the children and their families
- Previous experience managing Sunday Schools and volunteers will be a bonus.
